PROJECT DESCRIPTION

One of the main objectives of the EU Green Deal is to engage, support and accelerate the transition of EU companies towards a sustainable growth model. The EnergyEfficiency4SMEs project over 36 months will:

- Directly support 1000 companies in the implementation of energy audit recommendations
- 140 new energy audits carried out within the project's lifetime
- 1000 Number of company staff with improved skills / knowledge
- 200 Number of energy auditors / other stakeholders with improved skills / knowledge
